When you start the game, you can choose to set your game in different settings: fantasy, mystery, zombies, apocalyptic, cyberpunk, or custom where the system asks you to describe who you are and it uses this to design the game in that genre. You don't need an account to play, but if you want to be able to come back to your game later on, you will need to create an account to save. Also, you only get so many actions every 9-hour period with the free account. Paid membership plans come with extra benefits: more actions, enhanced AI storytelling, do-overs, advanced world and character customization, and premium themes. Avaturn is a realistic avatar creator that can be used for games, apps and metaverses. It uses a real photo to generate avatars. To use this, you need to create a free account. When you get started you will use your phone to scan a QR code that will then direct you to take three photos on your phone of your face. One straight forward, one turned to the left, and one turned to the right. Once your photos are uploaded you will now edit your body, hair style, Clothing, and pose. You are limited in what choices you have in these areas. You can download a photo you created of your avatar or use it in other advanced graphic/animation formats.
